

Simple Block Stitch

This stitch is worked in multiples of 5 (=1). A good sized throw will need a foundation chain of 230 + 1. You can chain any size you like. This pattern lends itself well to using multiple colours. Alternating colours on each row achieves a nice effect. To make the foundation more sturdy we add a row of trebles.

Tools & Materials

DK yarn in colour(s) of your choice 4mm crochet hook Yarn needle. Scissors

Foundation chain

Chain multiples of 5 and as an extra chain

Row 1 (Base row)

ch 3 (counts as a false treble), [if chaining 3 makes the stitch appear too loose then just chain 2] 1 tr into each stitch


Row 2

Chain 5, dc into space between the fifth and sixth trebles, ch 4 dc, (repeat to end)

Row 3

ch 3 (counts as a false treble), 5 tr into each ch 4 sp.

Repeat rows 2 & 3 until your reach the size you require.
